

ORDINANCE NO. 949

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROHIBITION AGAINST ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES IN CITY PARKS: ARTICLE 12 CHAPTER 1 SECTION 12-110 OF THE ORDINANCE CODE OF THE CITY OF DOWNS, KANSAS, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DOWNS:

Section 1. That Section 12-110 of Article 12, Chapter 1, of the Ordinance Code of the City of Downs, Kansas be amended to read as follows:

12-110. PROHIBITION AGAINST ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES. a) It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to use, consume or have on the premises of any park within the city any alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage.

b) The prohibition in (a) and Section 3-104 may be waived by a special permit issued by the Governing Body. Some factors to be considered before the issuance of this permit are: Nature of event (civic only), enclosed area, properly licensed, and amount of disturbance to the neighborhood.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
