

ORDINANCE NO. 951

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING THE UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE BY REFERENCE. (Published August 29, 2013)

An ordinance regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the city of Downs, Kansas; incorporating by reference the "Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities," edition of 2013, with changes to Section 10.5 regarding the Unlawful Discharge of Firearms.

Be it Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Downs:

Section 1. INCORPORATING THE UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Downs, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 2013, prepared and published in book form by the league of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 951," with all sections of portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 2. ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS. Article 10.5 of said Uniform Public Offense Code is hereby supplemented, by adding the following subsection:

Section 10.5(e) To the discharge of a firearm during the slaughter of an animal at a facility licensed by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA).

Section 3. REPEAL. Ordinance number 939 is repealed.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in The Downs News and Times.


(b) All traffic violations which are included within this ordinance, and which are not ordinance traffic infractions, as defined in subsection (a) of this section, shall be considered traffic offenses.

Section 4. REPEAL. Ordinance number 938 is repealed.
